### **ITC orders 6<sup>th</sup> Chipping Line to increase capacity and quality**

Valmet has received an order from ITC Limited to supply a new wood chipping line to its pulp mill in Bhadrachalam. The delivery is part of ITC's ongoing improvement initiatives at the Bhadrachalam mill to increase chipping capacity with high-quality chips. The new line is designed for low wood losses, superior and even chip quality, as well as high availability and easy maintenance.

ITC is committed to investing in advanced technologies to strengthen its operational excellence and sustainability. Valmet's modern chipping solution will play a crucial role in its improvement initiatives at Bhadrachalam, enabling it to better serve the growing demand for high-quality paperboards and specialty papers. The new chipping line will enhance both productivity and efficiency while ensuring world-class quality. The order was received in the third quarter of 2025 and start-up of the new wood chipping line is scheduled for the end of 2026.

Valmet's delivery will consist of a chipping line with a log infeed conveyor, Valmet Disc Chipper GSN 750 and chip handling with Valmet Chip Screen CSE 1200 and Valmet Chip Cutter. The delivery includes machinery, commissioning, training and start-up supervision. The supervision of the mechanical installation of the chipping line will be carried out by Valmet.
